

A&E Department Extension Barnsley General Hospital Barnsley

Project requirement

This project involved extending NHS Barnsley Hospital's busy A&E department to include a new Minor Injuries unit. Although smaller in scale to other CPS projects, the medical implications demanded an intense attention to detail. The works had to be carried out in a live environment including working alongside hospital staff and patients. The new unit was to include the provision of five new treatment rooms and a secure nurse station.

CPS Involvement

Our contract required us to act as the mechanical sub-contractor to the main building contractor CD Potters Ltd. The contract included:

- **Modifying and extending the existing hot and cold water services**
- **Heating services**
- **Installation of a new heat recovery ventilation system**
- **The provision of medical gases to the new treatment area was also part of our works.**

Timescale

The program was twelve weeks, and to minimise disruption at the hospital required working out of hours. Frequent co-ordination meetings proved essential to running a smooth operation when working in a live environment.

Project resolution

The project was commissioned and successfully handed over in May 2011, with the busy A&E Department benefitting instantly as a direct result.
